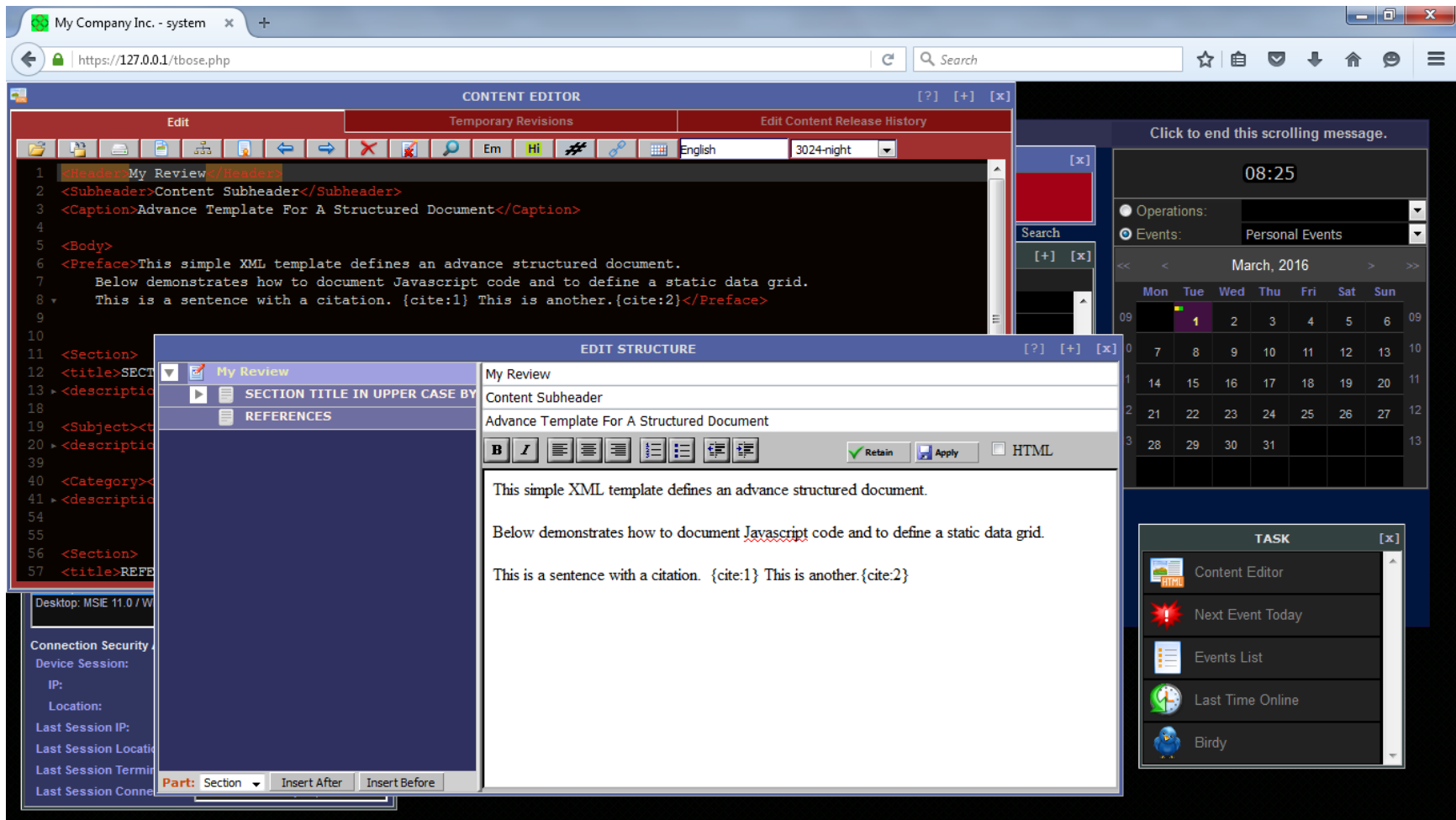

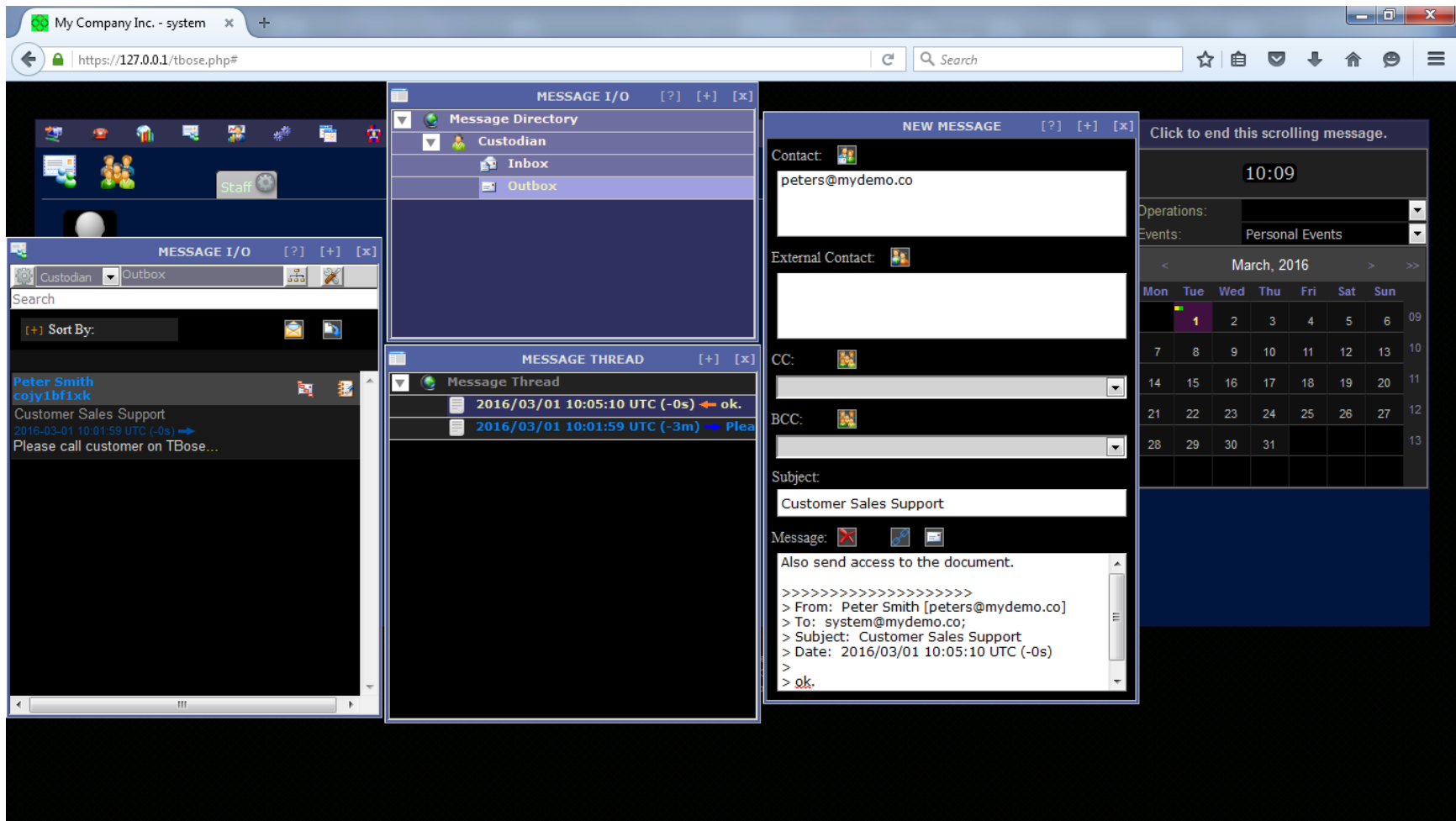

## System Calendar

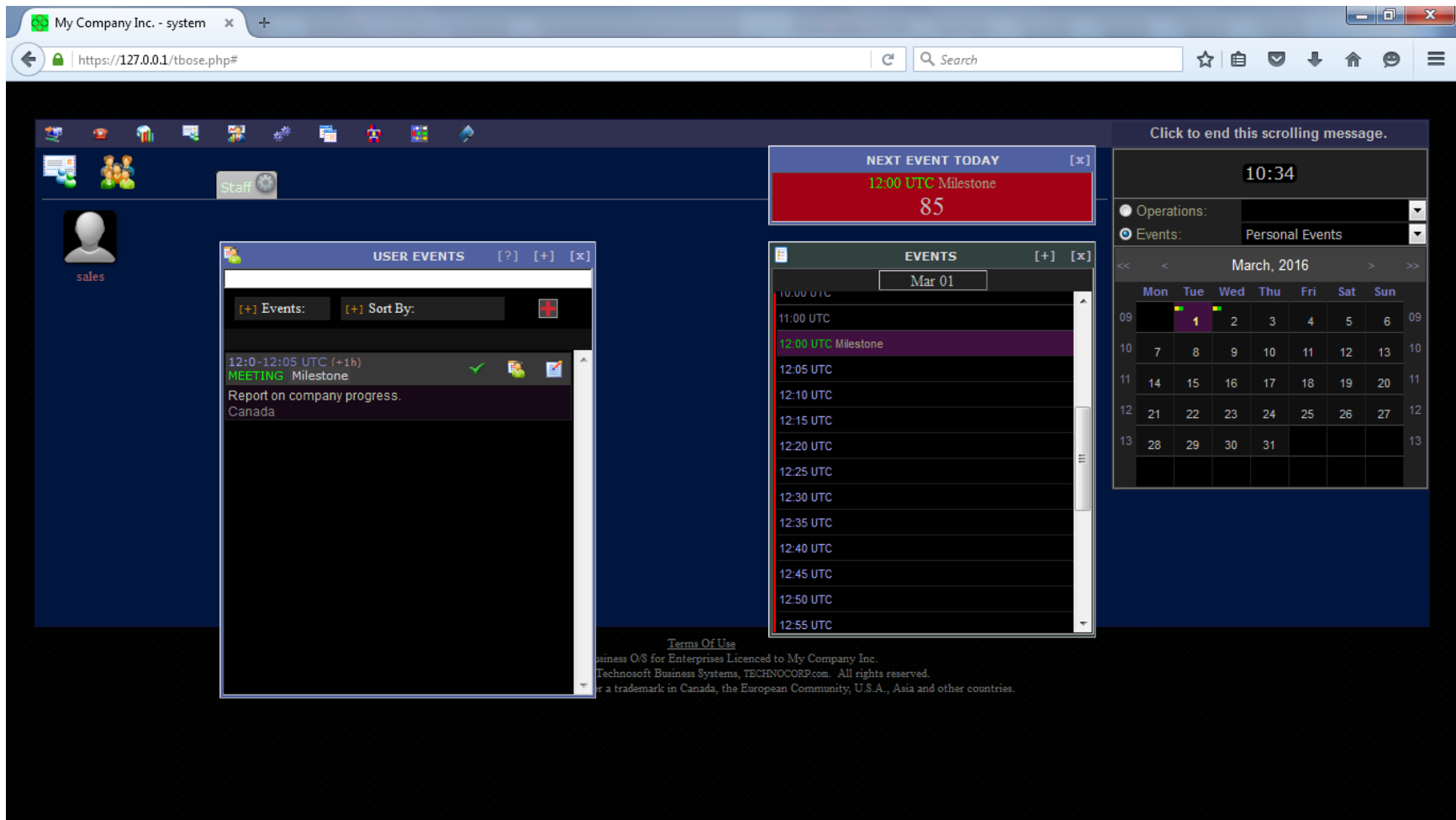
The enterprise calendar is standardized on ISO8601. Events are kept private within the system. Reminders ("TODO" events) can be associated with messages and content. Alternatively, public events can be created for display on the public website.
